

# **BIG RED KENO SAND VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE RULES**

- 1) NO CHILDREN WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SAND DURING GAMES. Children must have an adult not playing watching them at all times. Absolutely no exceptions. This is for the safety of the children as well as the other players.
- 2) No glass containers allowed on the deck or the sand during league play. Plastic cups are available. Please help keep the area clean. And "PLEASE" do not throw cigarette butts in the sand or on the ground!! Ashtrays & Trashcans are provided.
- 3) Any team that purchases for, or allows a minor to drink, will be dismissed from the league and banished from the bar. Anyone under "29" drinking alcohol, must wear a wristband per Big Red Restaurant & Sports Bar policy. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 4) The rope is considered in bounds. It is the responsibility of the players to keep the rope straight. All areas outside of the ropes are considered out of bounds.
- 5) All teams must have a Team Roster and Release of Liability form on file. Each team must sign the Release of Liability form once at the beginning and a team sign-in sheet at the beginning of each league night.
- 6) A team may borrow players as long as they have signed a release form and their team is not playing at the same time. Except for Tournament Time!!
- 7) A forfeit will be called 15 minutes after the starting time if not enough members are present to play.
- 8) A six-person team must have at least 3 women playing.
- 9) A five-person team may consist of 3 or more women, but not more than 2 men, but must be played with a dead spot. The dead spot will skip a serve for that team, so the opposing team may serve twice in a row.
- 10) Teams will be allowed to play with 4 members, 2 or more women but not more than 2 men, due to unforeseen circumstances, but must be played with two dead spots.
- 11) Teams will volley for first serve. After that, the losing team of each set will serve 1<sup>st</sup> the next set.
- 12) All games are played to 21. You must win by 2 with a 23-point cap. All games will be rally scoring.
- 13) The captain is the spokesperson of the team. If there is a problem, talk to your captain.
- 14) Substitutions will be done in the center back during a game. It is done during the rotation and before your team serves.
- 15) No more than three hits per side.
- 16) You cannot play off the fence, the border net, or the awning. You can play off the center net, but you cannot touch the net.
- 17) You can spike from the back row as long as you are 10 feet behind the net.
- 18) You make your own calls on the net, lines, and carries. If in question, replay.
- 19) If a member of each team blocks a ball simultaneously at the net, it is not considered a hit and whichever side the ball falls will be allowed 3 hits.
- 20) It is an automatic side-out when a player touches the net or goes under the net.
- 21) When the ball is hit on your side more than once, a woman must hit the ball at least once. The same player can hit the ball more than once provided it is not consecutive.
- 22) You can follow through over the net as long as you do not touch the net or carry the ball.
- 23) The ball can be played with any part of the body.
- 24) You can serve from anywhere along the back line.
- 25) Overhand and side arm serves are allowed. After three, you must break serve with one underhand before continuing overhand or side arm serves.
- 26) You cannot block a serve; all players' feet except the server must remain on the sand during a serve. Jump serves are allowed.
- 27) You can go out of bounds on your side to hit the ball, but the ball must go over the net on your court.
- 28) If a rule or play is in question, you can only question it during the game. Stop the game if necessary to verify. Once a game is played it is final.
- 29) These rules may be amended during the season as the season progresses.
- 30) Be sure to hose the sand off your feet before entering the bar.
- 31) Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times inside the bar.
- 32) Due to Severe weather games for any night may be called by Big Red personnel. If this occurs, your captain will be notified via telephone or text. Games will go, as a game not played meaning it doesn't count as a win or lose.
- 33) Net Serves will be allowed.
- 34) **REMEMBER: GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AND HAVE FUN!!**
